At the time when preparing this President's Report, Hong Kong's fourth wave of COVID-19 which has plagued the city since late November 2020, is nearing its end as illustrated by the Government's Independent Advisory Panel.

There are many studies across the globe quantifying the importance of COVID-19 vaccination to our future outlook and is being recommended as the most direct means and effective measure in combating the pandemic. Recent experiences in other parts of the world show that a higher percentage of population vaccinated against COVID-19 can facilitate the return to normalcy. Vaccination against COVID-19 will not only protect oneself, but also one's family and friends, as well as the community.

To stave off a possible fifth wave of COVID-19 infections, HKSPD urges all our members to make a concerted effort in supporting COVID-19 vaccination programme launched by the Government. We strongly encourage our fellow members, dental colleagues and respective clinical staff to receive vaccination as soon as possible and may also consider to implement incentive policy for vaccination encouragement to subordinates such as granting paid leave for each dose of vaccine.



THE 29TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING



The 29th Annual General Meeting took place on 17 June 2020 at the Craigenower Cricket Club. Here is a summary of the information covered during this well attended meeting.

President's Report

PDAA biennial meetings has been rescheduled and the next meeting in Seoul will be tentatively scheduled in 2022. The 28th Annual Scientific Meeting together with 91st, 92nd and 93rd Scientific Meetings held successfully with overwhelming participation throughout the period from May 2019 to June 2020. The Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Cap. 633) as gazetted since November 2018 regulates all PHF operators to apply for licenses or letters of exemption for performing MAC procedures.

Honorary Treasurer's Report

As at 1 Jan 2021, there were a total of 88 members, including 46 full members, 24 associate members, 1 affiliate, 15 student members, 1 life member and 1 honorary member. HKSPD maintained our membership of 4 major local and overseas dental /medical organizations, ie. HKDA, FMSHK, IAPD and PDAA. The society had an accumulated surplus slightly over HK\$1M in the last financial year.

Constitution Discussion

Ms. Eliza Chang, our legal advisor reported that our constitution is out-dated and recommended for an update to cover all previous amendments and few corrections.

There are altogether 9 sections to the Constitution which includes:

- Section 1: Definition
- Section 2: General Membership
- Section 3: Types of Members and its Rights and Entitlement
- Section 4: Executive Committee
- Section 5: General Meetings
- Section 6: Executive Committee Meetings
- Section 7: Society's Funds
- Section 8: Dissolution of the Society
- Section 9: Amendments to the Constitution

New additions were also proposed under Sections 5 & 6 on General Meetings and Executive Meetings. New amendments include:

- Section 6 – Executive Committee Meetings
 - Item #6 - it has agreed to remove the last line.
 - Item #8 – It has agreed to remove the resolution in order to restrict the flexibility and it may reverse if needed in the future.
 - A suggestion to add Proxy but substantial amendments may be required, thus it will not be covered and may reconsidered at a later date.
- Section 7 – Society's Funds
 - How to process donations funds was brought up with no further resolution to the matter.

DPL License

- The society will help members getting DPC license before expiry
- A certificated training course on dental sedation safety will be set up through the College of Anesthesiology
- It was suggested that task force can be developed to help members in obtaining the license.
- Ultimately, a good standard for private practice will help the sustainability of our profession and internationally recolonized high level of service.


